- 1. Are you independently owned or are you part of a franchise?
- 2. Do you receive compensation from 3rd parties?
- 3. Will your recommendations be unbiased and not based on advertising fees, directory listings, or "pay to play" editorials?
- 4. Are you contractually obligated to anyone?
- 5. Are you contractually aligned with a nonprofit?
- 6. Do you have to meet a sales quota?
- 7. Do you actually go to each site and check to see if the operations are as stated? In other words, "boots on the ground"?
- 8. Do you offer one on one, in-person service?
- 9. Do you research all alternatives?
- 10.Can you legally make recommendations?
- 11.Do you deliver a custom, comprehensive portfolio?
- 12.If so, how many properties will be listed?
- 13.Do you offer pre and post move assistance?
- 14. How much will you charge for this service?

They should not be charging you for this service. They are compensated by the place you choose at a fair rate.

15. Will you double check to make sure I get a fair rate or take advantage of any "specials"?

16.Do you check a facilities licensing?

17. Are you a licensed Senior Real Estate Specialist?

18. What other certifications do you have that qualify you for this job?
